<p>14% of you said we didn't make you aware of what your child was learning during the year</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Curriculum intent statements are shared on the website • Links to curriculum referenced in the weekly Newsletter • Teachers will share the topics the children will be studying from September 2022 • Yearly over views are on the website • Links to any sites or documents that can support the children's learning will be shared with parents • Parent meetings are planned for twice a year where teachers will share with parents the work their child is doing in more detail and the progress they are making. • Pupil Showcase events will also take place twice a year from September 2022
<p>12% either disagreed or did not know if concerns were dealt with properly</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage parents to raise their concerns straight away with the class teacher either via phone call or email. • If still not satisfied then the concern to be raised with the Head who will respond as soon as possible. • Meetings face to face will be arranged to resolve any issues which may remain • School has an open door policy so parents can contact us freely when they need to.
<p>8.3% either disagreed or did not know that we make sure the children are well behaved.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We expect the highest standards of work and behaviour from all our children. • Classroom rules and school rules are shared with all children and serious incidents are recorded and logged • Serious behaviour incidents are reported to the Head and parents informed

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share our behaviour expectations with parents at the beginning of the academic year and on the website so they can be referred to if required. • We will be consulting on our behaviour policy in the latter part of the summer term
<p>12% agreed that their child had been bullied and that the bullying had been dealt with quickly</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We take any form of bullying very seriously • Deal with any bullying quickly, listening to the 'victim' and the 'bully' and deciding on the most suitable way to deal with the situation. • Contact the parents of those involved. • Interventions and support strategies will be offered to young people as needed
<p>20% either disagreed or didn't know if the school has high expectations for their child</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers set demanding lessons and have exceptionally high expectations for the children. • We will review the nature of our challenges and intensify where necessary. • We will share expectations at the beginning of the year and at regular intervals via the newsletter and website. • We will review our approach to rewards and awards
